Are you Ready to Apply?



The Application process for domestic students and international students are basically the same, except that international students typically need to provide English proficiency test score (TOEFL or IELTS), in addition to the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) score, and accredited transcripts. Some institutions like Columbia University require a transcript evaluation, which is a fee-based service provided by a third-party agency like World Education Service (WES). Admission for graduate schools in the U.S adopts a holistic strategy based on the personal statement, resume, test scores, recommendation letter, and writing samples or interviews.

Application for graduate schools are competitive and stressful, thus it is recommended that prospective students plan about 10 months in advance. Deadlines for the application of Ph.D. programs for fall semester are in December or January, while the deadlines for Master programs may extend to March or early April. Prospective students also should consider the expenses for study and living since financial aid and grants are not guaranteed for all programs. International applicants should start the visa application as soon as they get the acceptance letters. Financial proof of one year's expenses is required for the visa application.

The keys to successful application is to plan ahead, stay organized, and ask for help when needed. Princeton Review, US News, and Peterson Guide are great sources for graduate college ranking, program introduction, and free online practice test for TOEFL or GRE. Graduate program directors, faculty members, current or former students are other potential sources of information for prospective students.



Final Exams at the American Universities

When attending colleges in the United States, it is common to have exams scheduled throughout the semester. Especially when it comes down to the end of the semester, there are a few different ways of testing your knowledge of the material. The most common form of final examination is an in-class test. Other forms include take-home exam, project, group presentation, and others.


The week before final week is called dead week, named this because of the amount of stress students experience, and the lack of sleep that usually occurs due to extensive study. At the Iowa State University, dead week is an official university-recognized event, where mandatory quiet hours are practiced and student organizations are not allowed to meet.

The final week runs on a completely different schedule than the semester, allowing enough time for an exam and ensuring that one test doesn't overlap another test. The college publishes with a schedule for the final week, giving each course a 2-hour slot for the exam. The finals start anywhere between 7:30 am to 8:15 pm.

Scotcheroos: A traditional dessert in Iowa

Ingredients

- 1 cup light corn syrup
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup peanut butter
- 6 cups Rice Krispies cereal
- 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate morsels
- 1 cup butterscotch chips

Instructions

1. Place corn syrup and sugar into 3-quart saucepan.
2. Cook over medium heat, stirring frequently, until sugar dissolves and mixture begins to boil.
3. Remove from heat.
4. Stir in peanut butter. Mix well.
5. Add rice krispies cereal. Stir until well coated.
6. Press mixture into 13 x 9 x 2-inch pan coated with cooking spray. Set aside.
7. Melt chocolate and butterscotch chips together in 1-quart saucepan over low heat, stirring constantly.
8. Spread evenly over cereal mixture.
9. Let stand until firm. Cut into 2 x 1-inch bars when cool.
